Poster Presentations

In the following you will find recommendations related to

Before you start ...

Consider the following questions:

- What is the goal of your poster presentation? ...present new results, present open questions, new issues, instigate new research, collaboration, ...
- What is the background of people reading the poster?
- What are the interests of people reading the poster?

Preparing the poster

- Structure your presentation
 - Suggested structure: Title authors' names and affiliation objective – method – results – discussion and conclusion.
 - Balance the space dedicated to each of these parts, do not use more space for introductory explanations than for methods or results.
 - Place the title prominently at the top of the poster and provide contact details. The title should be catching and short.
 - Use visual tools to clearly mark different parts of the poster: labels for different elements like 1, 2, 3 or A, B, C may help the viewer to follow your display.
- Concentrate on the core message
- Have clear statements and concise conclusions that grab the reader's attention.
- Use well readable fonts and font size, and legible and self-explanatory diagrams
 - Recommended minimal font size for an A0-poster is 30 points for text and 60 points for the title.
 - Simplify graphs, use legends.

1-minute espressi talks (oral poster introductions)

- We recommend authors of poster presentations are prepared to provide a summary (1-2 min/1-2 slides) of their contribution during the respective oral session.
- For most sessions time for such 1-minute talks is foreseen either during the oral programme or at the start of the poster session; please check the programme of your session on the website, in the ems2016 or in the programme book for details.
- You may also be asked ad hoc by the session chair for a summary presentation in case a gap should occur in the oral programme.
- You may want to bring A4-print-outs of the poster and attach them to the poster board; interested viewers can then take one along and do have your contact details.
